Profiling	Tongue & groove 4 sides

Wood species	European oak
Botanical name	quercus robur
Area of growth	France
Classification	Chablis / Campagne / Rustic B, symbol #, according to "Classifications for solid oak lamparquet used in the Benelux". A more strict classification than the EN 13227
Sound sapwood	Permitted without limit to size or quantity, if these do not impair the strength or the wearing quality of the wood flooring.
